



Gary Giardina: Clifton's 9th Police Chief

Captain Gary Giardina has been named Chief of Police effective March 1 by City Manager Al Greco. The 52 year old, who grew up in Clifton but now lives in Wayne, replaces Robert Ferreri, who has served in that capacity since June 1, 2002. A 1976 CHS grad, Giardina became a police officer in 1978 under the CETA program and was permanently appointed to the force on Sept. 2, 1982. 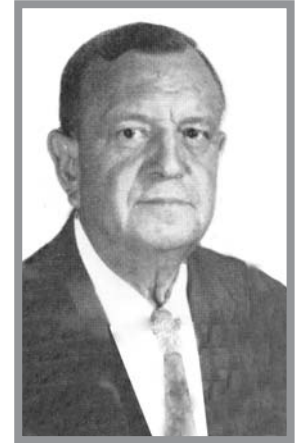
